











# MARUNOUCHI AREA MAP

## Rest Area (Public Area)

### 1 Ichigokan Square

This lush green rose garden has an open-air terrace cafe and bar.

### 4 Marunouchi oazo Rooftop Terrace

Rooftop garden located on the 7th floor of the Marunouchi oazo building, where visitors may sit on benches and enjoy the surrounding greenery.  
11am-5pm

### 2 Shin-Marunouchi Bldg. 7th Floor Terrace

The Marunouchi House Terrace on the 7th floor of the Shin-Marunouchi Bldg. has cafes and restaurants that overlook Tokyo Station.

11am-11pm  
\* Some restaurants open until 28:00 (4 am)



### 5 Marunouchi Bldg. 5th Floor Terrace

Here is a perfect view that overlooks the Tokyo Station building and the plaza in front of the station. KITTE, the new building on the site of the old Tokyo Central Post Office, is to the right.

11am-8pm

### 3 Nakadori benches

Benches are set at various locations on the sidewalks on both sides of the street. Ideal for a short break while enjoying the view of the artwork and landscape.



### 6 Hotoria Square

This is a large (3000m<sup>2</sup>), lush green community square that borders the Imperial Palace. A restaurant sits in front of the square and provides an urban oasis where visitors can rest and relax.
